SHOW REGULATIONS

1. This show will be conducted under the standardised **Uniform Guidelines of the Exhibition Poultry Association of NSW Inc.**
2. All breed classes will be judged to the standard found in **the Australian Poultry Standards - Second Edition & the Addendum**, a copy of which may be perused at the Secretary's office, with the exception of provisional classes and developmental classes.
3. All care will be taken of exhibits, but the club cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to the birds over the duration of the show.
4. No fowl to be handled after penning without the authority of the stewards.
5. Only the water containers supplied by the club are to be used.
6. All exhibits must be bona fide property of the exhibitor and any attempt to misrepresent will result in disqualification.
7. **All birds must be clean and any bird infested with vermin or diseased will be rejected, and removed from the pavilion and entry fees will be forfeited. Furthermore, due to biosecurity concerns, an exhibitor who has one bird rejected, will be asked to remove all of their entries.**
8. Judging will be "open", but onlookers must remain **quiet** and maintain a respectable distance from the Judges and Stewards.
9. **At the conclusion of the show every exhibitor will be required to clean out their own pens with the equipment provided.**
10. The club reserves the right to substitute a Judge or Judges if deemed necessary.
11. It is expected that all entries received will be accepted, unless all pens have been filled prior to the closing date for entries. The committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries from any one exhibitor, in any one class, if deemed necessary. Large fowl and waterfowl pens are limited to 250 birds in total.
12. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that birds have been entered into the correct class. Birds entered into the wrong class will be passed over by the judge with forfeiture of entry fees.
13. Junior exhibitors must be aged between 6 and 16 and must be present to pen and unpen their birds. **This rule will be strictly enforced.**
14. **NO SMOKING INSIDE THE PAVILION AT ANY TIME**
15. **PROVISIONAL COLOURS** in Orpingtons are Lavender, Splashed, Chocolate, Spangled & Jubilee. In Wyandottes the colours are Red Partridge, Blue Laced Red, Blue Marked Columbian & Blue Partridge. In Brahma the colours are black, blue, blue light, blue buff columbian, blue partridge, blue dark, silver laced, gold laced, blue laced gold, buff laced, cuckoo, barred buff columbian, silver creel, pile, birchen, salmon, blue salmon, speckled, blue speckled. Birds entered in the provisional classes will be judged to standards supplied by the Orpington Club of Australia, the Wyandotte Club of Australia and the Brahma & Cochin Club of Australia.

SCHEDULE ABBREVIATIONS

The following abbreviations are used in the individual breed classes in this schedule.

The colours referred to are colours that are recognised in the Australian Poultry Standards.

Please note that where a colour is not standardised for a breed, birds of that colour must be shown in the developmental section, unless a provisional standard has been supplied by the relevant breed club.

ARC - This abbreviation stands for Any Recognised Colour and means any colour that is **standardised** within the Australian Poultry Standards for the breed in question.

AORC - This abbreviation stands for Any Other Recognised Colour and is used for breeds where classes are provided for some of the standardised colours, but not all. Once again the colour must be standardised for the breed in the Australian Poultry Standards.

AOERC - This abbreviation stands for Any Other Eligible Recognised Colour and is used in the Rare Variety section for breeds where there has been an exclusion of one or more colours. Again the colour must be recognised for the breed in the Australian Poultry Standards.
